CRUISING WITH INFANTS

Packing Suggestions

Whilst your luggage will be delivered to your room, a day bag will carry you through until your stateroom is ready. Dress comfortably for Embarkation Day and pack your day bag with medication (in their original containers), Passport and/or required citizenship documentation, mobile phone, wallet, camera & accessories (batteries, memory card, etc.) extra prescription glasses or contact lenses, sunscreen, hat, sunglasses, swimsuit and cover-up, snacks & a water bottle. It is recommended to carry important items with you & not in your luggage.

Clothing Tropical itineraries or summer travel – Bring lightweight clothing such as shorts, slacks, sundresses, jeans and short-sleeved or sleeveless tops.

Cooler climates & winter travel such as Alaska & Canada – Pack warmer clothing and layering is recommended. Items including jackets, sweatshirt or sweater, gloves, beanie / hat, coat, waterproof and windproof coat, long pants or jeans, sturdy footwear (boots or rubber-sole shoes) and an umbrella or poncho.

Footwear – You may want to do some walking during port stops, so be sure to pack comfortable shoes like boat shoes, sandals or athletic shoes.

Sun wear – Swimsuits, hats or visors, sunglasses and sunscreen are a must for most tropical itineraries.

Costumes – During themed cruises and onboard celebrations like Pirate Night, Guests are invited to dress in costume.

Dressy attire – If you are planning to dine at Palo, Palo Steakhouse, Enchanté or Remy during your cruise, be sure to pack appropriate more formal clothing. For more on dinner attire, see the Dress Code page.

Corrective lenses – If you wear prescription glasses or contact lenses, be sure to pack spare glasses or extra contacts.

Stroller – It is recommend you bring your own stroller. However a limited number of strollers are available for rent on board.

Golf clubs – If you plan to golf at any of the port stops, you are welcome to bring your clubs. Please note that clubs do not count against your 2-bag limit, but you will need to store them in your stateroom.
